Révélation Lumière Project

The former “École Louis Lumière” is located near the Noisy-Champs RER A station, the future hub of the eastern part of the Ile-de-France region connected to lines 15 and 16 of the Grand Paris Express, and line 11 of the metro.

Close to the Cité Descartes Sustainable City Cluster, the 3.8 hectare site is at the heart of a residential area made up of large housing estates and detached houses. Entirely wooded, it is conducive to the regeneration of the district, with the enhancement of the architectural and landscape heritage.

The **Révélation Lumière project** (winner of the call for architecture and urban planning projects Inventons la Métropole du Grand Paris, IMGP 2) will be a place of research and experimentation, a factory and showcase of a human city where life is good. In France, it will be the first hub in the ecodesign of the sustainable and inclusive city of tomorrow.

Révélation Lumière will include a coworking space (Le Révélateur, formerly known as École Louis Lumière), a third area with a café-canteen, a modular space, a repair workshop, climbing walls, etc. The project includes a residential area that encourages diversity and exchanges through its multi-faceted programme initiatives.

Educational and fun activities for users and residents will be continuously organised. The vegetable garden and the shared gardens will help the community in developing new ecological habits.

This new district will be built around a central park with a water feature.
